Programme of Studies for September 2010**

CERTIFICATE COURSE IN:

COUNSELLING – <i>The emphasis is on both the theory and practice in counseling. This will equip persons to function creatively as Counselors.</i>
THEOLOGY, HUMAN SEXUALITY & HIV AND AIDS – <i>Equips the learner with the knowledge, attitude, and skills to provide care and counseling for persons infected with, and affected by, HIV & AIDS...</i>
SUNDAY SCHOOL INSTRUCTION – <i>Designed for Christian Educators, this course provides a practical exposure to instructional design, and the requisite skills set to develop as Christian Educators.</i>
STRESS MANAGEMENT – <i>Stress arises when individuals perceive that the demands on them exceed their ability to cope. This Stress Management course will help individuals identify stress in self and others, and the strategies to manage and prevent stress.</i>
ETHICAL AND MORAL PHILOSOPHY – <i>Ethics define our moral duties and obligations, which guides our behaviour. This course examines some of those moral and ethical problems facing individuals, and explores strategies to raise the ethical standards.</i>

MISSION STUDIES – *A denominational specific course of studies which will allow individuals to reflect on traditional and contemporary writers in the fields of evangelism, theology and mission. It is also designed to equip persons with knowledge, attitudes and skills to function as evangelists in particular faith communities.*
(Strand 1-ANGLICAN) – (Strand 2-BAPTIST)

DIPLOMA COURSE IN:

CHAPLAINCY – <i>This course adopts a professional approach to ministry and evangelism, and provides the knowledge, attitude, and skills set necessary to exercise the church's ministry and evangelical practice under varying circumstances within organizations and civic institutions.</i>
ADVANCED COUNSELLING – <i>This course builds on the knowledge and skills acquired in the Counselling 1 of the Certificate in Counselling. This is accomplished through interactive seminars and workshops, as well as, practical reflection experienced in real life counseling situations.</i>
ADVANCED THEOLOGY, HUMAN SEXUALITY & HIV AND AIDS – <i>Provides the opportunity for the learner to offer group and individual counseling on how to manage HIV and AIDS, and how to facilitate support groups for persons infected with the virus or affected by the disease.</i>
LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT – <i>Provides individuals with the requisite knowledge and learning experience to facilitate for personal introspection. Individuals will leave the course with a plan of action which will enhance their self-confidence and develop their leadership potentials.</i>
